# MSSM Friendship Scholarships, funded by Cookies for Scholarships

### Who is eligible?

Any incoming freshman UC Merced student, from any high school in the United States.

- No GPA requirement
- No sports or extracurricular activities required
- No income requirement

## The Heart of the Friendship Scholarship:

First, an applicant must demonstrate *friendship* qualities. These qualities are described through the applicant's personal letter on the meaning of friendship, and what it has meant in their life.

A friend of the applicant, who is a peer, and close in age must write a letter of recommendation, about the friendship qualities of the applicant. Some of these qualities may include a devotion to serve others, a commitment to improve our community, and a sense of love, loyalty, ethics, and compassion.

We are looking for young people who have shown that they already give of themselves to others. We want to help them achieve their education in a variety of fields, at the college or university of their choice, knowing that they have a strong likelihood of further enriching our world in years to come. We are looking for great friends, knowing they will enhance their communities and their professions everywhere, touching the lives of others and making a difference! This tremendous diversity has one thing uniting them: these people care about others.

Friendship scholarships are awarded at \$4,000 each, and renew annually for four years of college for students maintaining a 2.5 GPA and a full-time course load. (Recipients of scholarships funded by Cookies for Scholarships must attend UC Merced for all four years to receive all four years of funding.)

# Building a bright future for tomorrow

Often times, it can be difficult to quantify the value of friendships and the qualities of a community leader. However, we strive to express the importance of our mission through the values and success that we see in our scholarship recipients. Those values include:

#### **Supporting and Serving Others**

Of the four recipients graduating from college this year, two intend to become doctors. Many other recipients are also studying Medicine, Public Health, Dentistry, Law and Genetics.

As volunteers, they have served in the Merced Rescue Mission, "Week of Welcoming" for college freshmen, food and toy drives, and helping a family after losing their home in a fire.

#### **Professional Growth and Education**

Seven of the first eight graduating seniors, have continued on to graduate school.

One student was accepted after her freshman year at UC Berkeley into a six-year combination BS/MD program in another state.

#### **Experiencing Diversity**

Four have done overseas studies for a semester.

One scholarship recipient participated in a mission trip to Australia.

Another recipient has plans to lead medical missions to foreign countries after completing a medical residency program in California.

#### **Community Involvement**

Nearly all of our scholarship recipients become involved in community work while in school. They have participated in conducting medical interviews for homeless and uninsured, coordinating beach clean-up events, youthmentoring programs, and more.

One scholarship recipient won an NCAA soccer championship, then shared her gifts by leading soccer camps and coaching youth soccer teams.
